Scholarship Program Announcement



Kimberly Clark Credit Union, headquartered in Memphis, TN, has served the financial needs of Kimberly Clark Corporation Employees and family members since 1947. In addition to the financial services we provide, a major purpose of the credit union is to educate our members about financial matters and the wise use of credit. Our goal is to improve the economic well-being of our members, our community, and our country.

Our support for education also includes aiding the aspirations of young adults. To demonstrate our commitment, Kimberly Clark Credit Union is proud to sponsor a scholarship program for graduating high school seniors. **Twenty scholarships of \$1,000 each** may be awarded to assist students studying for a two-year or four-year undergraduate degree. The scholarships are one-time awards.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

1. Student must be a child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a Kimberly Clark Credit Union member with an active account for at least one year.
2. Students must have a high school grade average of B or better, or a grade point average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
3. Students must be accepted as a full-time student (12 units) to attend an accredited college, university, or technical college for enrollment in the summer or fall semester of 2026.

HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY:

1. Submit a completed scholarship application that is available at www.kimberlyclarkcu.org or by calling Kimberly Clark Credit Union at 901-521-4646 or 1-800-462-2777.
2. Submit a copy of your school transcript to confirm your cumulative grade of at least a B or 3.0.
3. Submit two brief letters of reference. These may be from your high school teacher or guidance counselor, community leader or church leader.
4. Submit a typed essay (300 words or less) on the topic, "What I've Learned About Managing Money". (**The essay is very important! All applicants will be honor students, but the essay will give you the opportunity to stand out from the rest. Don't copy material from the internet. Write from your heart.**)
5. Include a recent photo of yourself along with your application.
6. Deadline for returning scholarship applications is March 15, 2026.

SELECTION PROCESS:

1. Scholarships will be awarded on a nondiscriminatory basis.
2. Recipients will be selected based on an evaluation of the applications, essays, and letters of reference.
3. Recipients must submit evidence of enrollment before payment will be made to the college.
